Kenai Peninsula Borough (KPB) Coastal District staff reviewed the above noted project for consistency with KPB Coastal Management enforceable policies. The project is located at Mile 41 Sterling Highway in Section 16, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, Seward Meridian in a state owned gravel pit.

Scope of Work

The applicant, under contract with the State of Alaska Department of Transportation (ADOT), seeks to process sand and gravel material to create sand for delivery to the ADOT's Cooper Landing road maintenance yard. The process the applicant will use to produce the sand is a wet and dry screening method as called out in the applicant's contract. Air and water quality issues will be handled separately by the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation.

Findings

Inasmuch as this project takes place in an existing and approved upland sand and gravel site and not in a floodplain or stream, the project is consistent with Kenai Peninsula Borough Coastal Management Program enforceable policies.
