Subject: Tsalteshi Trails Extension

Dear Mr. Holt:

Kenai Peninsula Borough Coastal Zone Management Plan (KPBCZMP) staff reviewed the Coastal Project Questionnaire and attached project description provided by the Tsalteshi Trails Association to determine whether the project is consistent with the enforceable policies of the Plan. The project will add 2 kilometers of lights to the ski trails and a driveway and parking lot at Kalifornsky Beach Road and continue general trail improvements including a possible culvert.

This project is an extension of an existing trails network and is developed under a lease and development plan authorized by the Kenai Peninsula Borough. The Corps of Engineers determined that no permits were required following a review of the project in 2003. Corps of Engineers on-site review in June 2005 indicated no areas of concern regarding the location of planned trails.

KPBCZMP staff reviewed the proposed trails plan on-site and finds the project, as proposed, consistent with all enforceable and administrative policies of the Plan
