Subject: Right-of-way for 2 Existing Roads Off North Fork Road AK 0803-07AA

Dear Ms. Brudie:

The Kenai Peninsula Borough Coastal District has reviewed the subject project for consistency with standards of the Alaska Coastal Management Program and proposes that the project be found consistent with those standards.

Project Description and Scope

The project subject to this consistency review is to place public easements on two existing access roads that traverse state land, which were built in 1959 and in 1973. The easements would traverse state land in an easterly direction from North Fork Road (ADL 39502) to private land held by the applicant in two places:

Access Easement No. 1 would be 60' wide, approximately 705 feet long, and lies south of Anchor River within SE ¼ NW ¼ Section 27, Township 5S Range 14W, Seward Meridian, encompassing approximately 1.03 acres of state land.

Access Easement No. 2 would be 60 feet wide, approximately 200 feet long, and lies north of Anchor River within NE ¼ NW ¼ Section 27, Township 5S Range 14W, Seward Meridian, encompassing approximately .25 acre of state land.


No work is proposed associated with establishing easements on these existing access roads. The project area is located within the Anchor River/Fritz Creek Critical Habitat Area on the Kenai Peninsula.

Findings:

The scope of work does not involve work in important habitat hence there is no conflict with the State Standards of the Alaska Coastal Management Program covered under 11AAC 112.
